

**ORDINANCE NO. 514
BOROUGH OF PARKESBURG
CHESTER COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA**

**AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE BOROUGH COUNCIL OF THE
BOROUGH OF PARKESBURG TO ENTER INTERGOVERNMENTAL
COOPERATION AGREEMENTS WITH NEW GARDEN TOWNSHIP, KENNETT
SQUARE, AND OXFORD BOROUGHS UNDER THE AUTHORITY OF THE
INTERGOVERNMENTAL COOPERATION ACT**

BE IT ENACTED AND ORDAINED by Borough Council of the Borough of Parkesburg, Chester County, Pennsylvania, and it is hereby enacted and ordained by the authority of the same as follows:

Section 1. Legislative Intent And Applicability

The background of this Ordinance and the legislative intention of Borough Council of the Borough of Parkesburg (Borough Council") in enacting it are as follows:

- (a) The Borough of Parkesburg is a Borough governed by and under the laws of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania.
- (b) The Intergovernmental Cooperation Act, 53 Pa, C.S.A §2301, et seq., authorizes two or more local governments in the Commonwealth to jointly cooperate in the exercise or in the performance of their respective governmental functions, powers or responsibilities, so long as both municipalities adopt an ordinance so providing.
- (c) The Borough Council of the Borough of Parkesburg has determined that it is in the best interest of the Borough of Parkesburg to enter into agreements thereby permitting the use by Kennett Square, Oxford and Parkesburg Boroughs of the New Garden Township Police Department firing range.

Section 2. Intergovernmental Cooperation Agreement

The covenants, terms and conditions of the Intergovernmental Cooperation Agreements attached hereto as Exhibit "A" are hereby incorporated herein by reference.

Section 3. Duration of Agreement

The duration of the Agreements is one year with automatic one year renewals, unless and until terminated.

Section 4. Purpose and Objectives of the Agreements

The purpose of the Agreements is to provide for the use of the New Garden Township firing range by Kennett Square, Oxford and Parkesburg Boroughs under the terms set forth in the Intergovernmental Cooperation Agreements.

Section 5. Manner and Extent of Financing the Agreement

The manner and extent of financing of the Agreements is payment of a negotiated fee for use of the firing range.

Section 6. Organizational Structure of the Agreement

No new organization structure is necessary to implement the Agreements.

Section 7. The Manner in which Real or Personal Property shall be Acquired, Managed, Licensed or Disposed of

User shall be given permission to use the firing range under the terms set forth in the Intergovernmental Cooperation Agreements.

Section 8. Severability

If any sentence, clause, phrase or section of this Ordinance is for any reason found to be unconstitutional, illegal or invalid, such unconstitutionality, illegality or invalidity shall not affect or impair any of the remaining provisions, sentences, clauses, phrases, sections or parts of this Ordinance. It is hereby declared as the intention of the governing body that this Ordinance would have been adopted had such unconstitutional, illegal or invalid sentence, clause, phrase, section or part thereof not been included therein.

Section 9. Repealer


Any other Ordinance or parts thereof inconsistent with this Ordinance be and are hereby expressly repealed.

Section 10 Effective Date


This Ordinance shall become effective as provided by law.
