REQUEST FOR AN EXEMPTION FROM PARKESBURG STORMWATER MANAGEMENT ORDINANCE

I, _____, as the applicant, am requesting a stormwater management exemption as outlined in Section 106.A.4 of the Parkesburg Borough Stormwater Management Ordinance. Land improvements with existing structures may be exempted for an additional one thousand (1,000) square feet of impervious surface or five thousand (5,000) square feet of land disturbance in all Zoning Districts provided that flows from the site after development leave the site in the same manner as the pre-development condition and there are no adverse effects on adjacent properties.

Description of the Project*: _____

**The project description must demonstrate the proposed impervious is less than 1,000 square feet & the limit of disturbance is less than 5,000 square feet.*

As the applicant, I verify the following: *(please check all that apply)*

- The property is not located in flood plains or wetlands.
- The applicant is familiar with the Borough of Parkesburg Stormwater Ordinance and all work will conform to the applicable provisions of the Ordinance.

- No change in grades will result in new stormwater runoff patterns onto adjacent properties, and no concentrated discharge of stormwater runoff will be directed onto adjacent properties.
- The duration of construction is less than one business day for the gravel pad, construction of the pad will not be performed on a day when there is rain. In addition, the shed is pre-fabricated at the manufacturer and fully assembled before delivery, and is placed on top of the pad on a different date after the pad completion.
- The methods of construction will prevent the tracking of mud, sediment, and debris onto public thoroughfares. The pad location is into our property in a grassy area away from the street edge and sidewalk. However, any mud, sediment, or debris accumulating from the construction will be hand shoveled clean and swept within 4 hours of the end of construction.
- Unforeseen erosion and sedimentation control problems will be addressed and resolved as soon as possible.
- The gravel pad construction is less than one business day and all work will be contained on our property. There are no expected erosion or sedimentation issues expected as the work is performed on a day with no rain.
- There are no stormwater inlets within the vicinity of the project work.
- Construction waste including discarded building materials and litter will be removed by the gravel pad company immediately after pad construction and will be properly disposed.
- There will be no illegal or illicit discharges as a result of this project.
- We will conform to applicable federal and state regulations including Title 25 of the Pennsylvania Code, Chapter 92 and 102, regarding erosion and sediment control.
