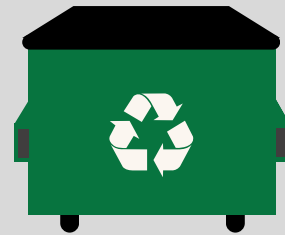


STORMWATER POLLUTION PREVENT FOR RESTAURANTS

Below are some helpful tips for preventing stormwater pollution:

PUT WASTE IN A BIN.

Grease and oils can clog pipes and pollute our water. Make sure grease is disposed of properly in used oil containers, grease traps, or recycled, and all food waste goes into trash cans or containers with a lid.



AVOID OVERFLOWS.

Keep outdoor waste containers closed and away from drains and streams. Make sure they are emptied or collected regularly to avoid overflows.

WIPE IT UP.

If you spill oil or grease outside, soak it up with an absorbent material. Sweep up trash and food scraps and dispose of in a garbage can.



PROPERLY DISPOSE OF WASTEWATER.

Never pour wastewater with a cleaning agent down a storm drain.
